
Subject: - Extension for the period of exports of broken rice (HS code 1006 40 00) from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 till 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 as mentioned in Notification No. 34 dt. 20.09.2022.

S.O. (E) The Central Government, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 read with section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, hereby extends the period for export of broken rice (HS code 1006 40 00) from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 till 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2022. All other conditions as contained in Notification No. 31 dated 08.09.2022 read with Notification No.34 dated 20.09.2022 remain the same.

2. The Notification will come into force with immediate effect.

**3. Effect of this Notification:**

Export of consignments of broken rice (ITC HS code 1006 40 00) as permissible under Notification No.31 dated 08.09.2022 read with Notification No.34 dated 20.09.2022 has been extended till 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2022.
